ISRS has constituted an award to be presented at the ACRS each year, namely the “**ISRS Asian Geospatial Award**” to recognize the outstanding contribution in the field of Remote Sensing and GIS Technology.

Hosted and organized by the Chinese (Taipei) Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing, National Central University, and Asian Association on Remote Sensing at TaiNEX2, Taipei, Taiwan from October 30 to November 3, 2023.

Eligibility Criteria to Apply:

1. The Author should be from the AARS Ordinary Member Countries/regions.
2. The paper submitted by the author must have remote sensing application relevant to the Asian region.
3. The use of the Indian Remote Sensing Satellite in the research work is necessary.
4. The Applicant will present the paper in the upcoming ACRS 2023 in Taiwan.
5. No age limit for applicants.

Evaluation and Selection:

- ❖ The evaluation committee/board for the selection of Papers will consist of:
 - President, ISRS, (Chairman)
 - General Secretary, AARS (Member)
 - Deputy General Secretary, AARS India (Member Secretary)
- ❖ The winner will be notified via email and will be announced at the closing ceremony of ACRS-2023.
- ❖ The prize money of the award will be **INR 25,000**.
